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NAPLAN 2024

About NAPLAN:

From Wednesday 13th March (Week 8) to Friday 22nd March (Week 9), students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 across Australian will be sitting the NAPLAN tests. The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is an annual assessment for students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. NAPLAN results allow parents/carers and educators to see how students are progressing in literacy and numeracy over time – individually, as part of their school community, and against national standards. The tests support monitoring and evaluating of the performance of schools and school systems in these fundamental capabilities. They also provide schools, states and territories with information about how education approaches are working, areas to be prioritised for improvement, and those schools requiring support in the teaching and learning of literacy and numeracy. The results can assist teachers by providing additional information to support their professional judgement about students' levels of literacy and numeracy attainment and progress.

NAPLAN is made up of tests in the 4 areas (or 'domains') of:

Reading

Writing

Conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation)

Numeracy

NAPLAN @ BSC:

Here at Burnett State College, we will be completing the NAPLAN tests online from Wednesday 13th March (Week 8) to Monday 18th March (Week 9), with time for any required catch ups in Week 9. **A schedule for the NAPLAN Tests can be seen on the following page.** Students will be completing the NAPLAN Tests in B3 and B4. These rooms are equipped with enough computers and headphones for each student. Students can bring their own headphones; however, they must have a wire (i.e. not Bluetooth connected).

NAPLAN Participation:

NAPLAN is for everyone. Adjustments are available for students with disability who have diverse functional abilities and needs. Schools can work with parents/carers and students to identify, on a case-by-case basis, reasonable adjustments required for individual students with disability to access NAPLAN. Adjustments should reflect the support normally provided for classroom assessments. To help inform these decisions, you may consult the NAPLAN public demonstration site, the NAPLAN (PDF 96 KB), or a series of videos on Accessibility, where parents/carers, teachers and students share their experiences in using NAPLAN adjustments.

Exemption:

In exceptional circumstances, a student with a disability that severely limits their capacity to participate in the assessment, or a student who has recently arrived in Australia and has a non-English speaking background, may be granted a formal exemption. If these situations apply to your child, please contact Mr Simon Graham (Principal@burnettsc.eq.edu.au) to set up a time to organise a formal exemption.

Withdrawal:

Students may be withdrawn from the NAPLAN testing program by their parent/carer for reasons such as religious beliefs or philosophical objections to testing. This is a matter for consideration by individual parents/carers in consultation with their child's school. A formal application in the manner specified by the relevant test administration authority must be received by the principal prior to testing. If you wish to withdraw your child from NAPLAN, please contact Miss Tahlia Perry (tjper1@eq.edu.au) or the school office (4161 3888) to obtain a NAPLAN Withdrawal form.
