- maintain senior student exit target rates of 100% QCE/ QCIA attainment and Vocational Education success
- ensure 100% of students' results are tracked and have academic achievement targets set on a term by term basis
- ensure 100% of staff using the Explicit Teaching instructional framework in classroom settings
